LIGHTING

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for unmetered outdoor lighting service to individual Consumers where service can be supplied from existing secondary voltage facilities of the Cooperative, all subject to the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations as they currently exist or may be amended from time to time.

RATES

As indicated in the Table on Sheet 2.

Energy usage is also subject to the Power Cost Adjustment and Property Tax Rider.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

- 1. The Cooperative shall furnish, install, operate, and maintain the outdoor lighting equipment including lamp, luminaire, bracket attachment, and control device on an existing pole at a location mutually agreeable to the Cooperative and the Consumer. The light shall be electrically connected so that the power for the operation of the light does not pass through the meter for the Consumer's regular usage.
- 2. If a new pole is necessary, additional charges will be assessed as indicated in table below (Sheet 3) or as determined by the Cooperative based on the quality of the fixture(s), capital costs, maintenance costs, availability, customer acceptance, and such factors. Any existing customers may be grandfathered in at the Cooperative's option.
- 3. The Cooperative shall maintain the lighting equipment, including lamp replacement, at no additional cost to the Consumer.
- 4. The Cooperative shall not install or maintain any underground facilities.
- 5. Lamps shall be controlled by a photoelectric controller providing dusk to dawn service.
- 6. It shall be the Customer's responsibility to notify the Cooperative when the lighting system is not working on the Customer's premises.
